

11+ HUBS POLICY

This policy applies to all bookings made with Kingsbury Education for Our 11+ Hubs.

Who are 'we'?

In this policy, whenever you see the words 'We', 'Us' or 'Our', it refers to Kingsbury Education.

Your acceptance of this policy, and Our right to change and update it.

By booking and paying for Our 11+ Hubs, you agree to all our T&Cs. These can be found on Our website, kingsburyeducation.com. We have the right to change and update our policies at any time and the most up-to-date versions can be found on Our website. Please read these before making any payments to Us.

<u>11+ Hubs</u>

Pre-payment is needed to secure your child's place at one of Our 11+ Hubs.

11+ Hub sessions are always booked in multiples and the more you book, the cheaper each class becomes. All 11+ Hub sessions are booked in blocks of 20 sessions. However We can offer different denominations, at Our discretion, if, for example, less than 20 sessions remain until the 11+ tests. Each 20 session block is to be used within 22 weeks, giving flexibility to miss up to 2 sessions without losing them. If your child is unable to attend a session, please let us know at least an hour before the lesson. We must be informed in order to carry the session forward, ensuring your child doesn't miss out and can complete all booked lessons. This only applies to booking blocks of 20 sessions.

What you can expect from Our 11+ Hubs Our weekly 11+ Tuition Hub sessions are sequential and build on the learning that has taken place throughout the weeks before. We also rotate between English, Maths and Verbal Reasoning. It's a very good idea to prepare over time, regularly and consistently. That way, children make steady and considerable progress before their 11+ test. Each of our Hubs are taught by two of teachers, Peter and Franny, so the teacher to children ratios are very low. Our 11+ Hubs take place on a weekly basis and it's really important that children attend each week, as much as possible, in order to really get the most from them. If conditions out of Our control mean that Our 11+ Hubs cannot run, then either an alternative provision will be made or the session(s) will be added on to the end of your booking.
